Seriously, there are only five more opportunities to shop at the Friends' Used Book Sales that occur on *Saturdays twice a month from 10 am to 3 pm.* The remaining 2016 book sale dates are Oct 22, Nov 5 & 19 and Dec 3 & 17. Put these dates on your calendar! The book sales are in the Emma Blackburn Community Room at the Library at 5922 Clark Road. If you have never shopped at the book sale, you will be amazed at the quality, variety and affordability of our merchandise. Our books come from local donations - high quality, up-to-date material. Prices start at 50 cents for paperbacks, \$1 for hard covers. Books for children start at 25 cents. Special books will be marked higher. All proceeds benefit the library.

As fall is the season of Thanksgiving, I would like to thank all of our FOL members and volunteers. The Volunteer Luncheon is on Sat, Nov 12 at noon. Your annual membership fees are an integral source for the operation of our Paradise Branch. Annual memberships, along with the book sale revenue, provide opportunity for our talented librarians to develop and administer programs over and above what is allocated in the annual Butte County budget.

We also were able to purchase new paperback books to give to children and teens as a reward for reading 5 books or more. 
