FOL PURCHASES NEW COMPUTERS

What prompted a "Hurray, hurray," from Paradise Branch Librarian Brenda Crotts?

New computers are here!

Toward the end of 2012 the FOL board unanimously voted to purchase 9 new computers for the public workstations at the Library, and now they have been installed by Butte County's technical staff, which will also take care of maintenance.

Library staff is thrilled! They have been fielding complaints from the public about the old computers for years. The old computers were used hand-me-downs when they were installed, so they have never provided the kind of service Library patrons expect.

"We asked the county IT folks to see what was available based on our budget and our desire to have quality," says Ron Serrano, FOL past president.

After initial input, other quotes were obtained and discussed with the IT people. In the end, the county made a \$10,000 deal with Computers Plus in Chico for the hardware. Software and security for county purposes added another couple of thousand. FOL also purchased an additional self-checkout machine for \$3,000.

The new computers should be very useful for at least 5 years, are of the latest generation in terms of speed,

and have very current software capabilities.

Important purchases such as these are made possible by the continuing support of FOL by our community. Thank you!
