# THE PREZ SEZ... JOANNA GUTIERREZ, PFOL PRESIDENT

It is an honor to have been elected to serve as the 2016 President of the Friends of the Library (FOL) Board President and to welcome three new board members who bring a depth of knowledge, talent and insight for the betterment of our library. This year the Friends plan more outreach into the community. There will be a concentrated effort for **new friends** and renewed friendships by renewal of existing memberships and new friendships by persons who may either fill out the paper form in this newsletter OR by signing up ONLINE at <a href="www.pfol.org">www.pfol.org</a>. Online signups will streamline process, increase efficiency of renewals, as well as make us "green". Membership provides an easy and affordable way to donate to your library.

What do Friends do? The Friends' bi-monthly book sales provide for a \$25,000 annual budget for new reading material and to fund special out-reach programs such as the Summer Reading Program and recently the Valentine Day Big Band Concert. The Friends purchased the ten computers that you see in the library, the two self-checkout stations, and most recently provided the new study carrels for increased privacy. As for community partnerships, In 2015, we formed a formal partnership with the Paradise Masons to expand our parking lot capacities. The FOL Board approved up to \$40,000 to fund a **Public Works Capital Improvement Project** that will provide more parking spaces, safer access to facilities and improved traffic flow. This project will pave the way for greater PUBLIC participation in special events, including shopping at the book sale. The project will be completed this May under the direction of Butte County General Services Department.

Our priority for 2016 is to increase a public awareness of the value of our library, of volunteer service, and the importance of sustainable *voluntary* funding for our library. The Friends have scheduled "meetups" for poets, authors and artists to showcase their talents, and to serve as mentors for aspiring writers/artists of the future.

Our public library is a great institution, one that depends heavily upon volunteers to provide for its patrons. Franklin D. Roosevelt, U.S. president during the Great Depression, understood the importance of public libraries in a democratic society, describing them as the symbols of the freedom of the mind, essential to the functioning of a democratic society. Please visit the library and become a Friend this year.


We are raising money for our Summer Reading Program for new books to give to children who participate each summer and books for our collection relating to the summer reading themes.
